1. Except a man be born again

John 3:3 Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

John 3:5 Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

Jesus made these statements to a religious leader in Israel. It is not enough to live a good life or a religious life. You must be born again as you hear the Word of God and receive it. Jesus said in the same passage that, 'whosoever believeth on him should not perish but have everlasting life.' You are born again into the family of God by the Holy Spirit when you believe on the Lord Jesus Christ.

2. New Creature

2 Cor 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

Rom 12:1-2

1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

When we receive Jesus Christ as Lord of our life, we are born again. We are instantly a new creature. We have a new nature. We have the Holy Spirit who leads us in the right way. As we give ourselves over to God and to His Word, our mind and body will be transformed so that we will lay aside sinful deeds and do what is right before God.

3. Whosoever believeth on Him

Acts 10:43 "To Him all the prophets witness that, through His name, whoever believes in Him will receive remission of sins."

The only way to have your sins remitted, that is, not have them held against you is to believe on Jesus Christ. We can never through our own efforts pay or make up to God for our sins. God made a way for our sins to be put away from us. That way is to have them covered by the blood of Jesus Christ. In the Old Testament, animal sacrifices were made and blood was spilled to pay for our sins. We only have to believe in Jesus Christ, that He is in fact the Son of God. Believing means to adhere to or cling to; that is, we have to make Jesus the Lord of our life.

4. Kingdom of light

Col 1:13-14

13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love,

14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

John 8:12 Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."

The way to have the light of life in your life is to follow Jesus Christ. He is the One who delivers us from the power of darkness when we confess Him as Lord and believe that God raised Him from the dead. Let us realize that we are in Jesus, in whom we have been redeemed from sin and the power of it.

Matt 5:16 "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

5. Drink of the water of life

John 6:35 And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.

Isaiah 55:1-2

1 "Ho! Everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy and eat. Yes, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price.

2 Why do you spend money for what is not bread, and your wages for what does not satisfy? Listen carefully to Me, and eat what is good, and let your soul delight itself in abundance.

In each person there is a longing that can only be satisfied by Jesus Christ. Material things may give pleasure for a season, but they will not satisfy the long to be right with God. As we believe on Jesus Christ, our spiritual thirst is satisfied. Jesus gives us a well of water 'springing up into everlasting life.' As we come to Jesus Christ, our spiritual hunger is satisfied by the One who is the Bread of Life.

6. Came not to judge but to save

John 3:17-19

17 "For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. 18 "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. 19 "And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

John 12:47 "And if anyone hears My words and does not believe, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world but to save the world.

Jesus did not come to condemn the world. We do not have any right to condemn those who do not know Jesus. We are to let people know that Jesus saves. We are to let the light of Jesus shine so strongly in and through us that those we meet will have to make a clear decision to turn to Jesus or not to.

7. Life more abundantly

John 10:10 "The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

Luke 4:18 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; he has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed;

Jesus is come that we might have life and have it more abundantly. When Jesus is the Lord of our life, He is also the our Good Shepherd. We have eternal life with Jesus. We have abundant life here on earth with Jesus. As we trust in Jesus, He will lead us beside the still waters and into green pastures. The gospel to the poor is that Jesus gives eternal life and will help in this life. Trust Jesus now as Savior.

8. Saves to the uttermost

Heb 7:25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

Rom 8:34 Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.

Matt 12:20-21

20 A bruised reed He will not break, and smoking flax He will not quench, till He sends forth justice to victory;

21 And in His name Gentiles will trust."

As a Christian, Jesus is on your side! Jesus is not condemning, He is praying for you. Jesus is able and will save you completely as you come to Him. Jesus can and will deliver you from any wrong habit. Jesus will help even if you fall or get bruised. Jesus will help you even if at times you put out smoke instead of light to the world. Jesus is interceding that you will make it in this life and to heaven.

Heb 13:6 So we may boldly say: "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?"

9. Rest unto your Souls

Matt 11:28-30

28 "Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

29 "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

30 "For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

Isaiah 57:20 But the wicked are like the troubled sea, when it cannot rest, whose waters cast up mire and dirt.

Heb 4:3 For we who have believed do enter that rest, as He has said: "So I swore in My wrath, they shall not enter My rest," although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.

Rev 14:11 "And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day or night, who

worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name."

When we receive the Lord Jesus Christ as Savior, we have rest for our lives now and for eternity. As we are made right with God through Jesus Christ, we can rest in the righteousness of Jesus Christ. We then cease from our own efforts to be right. Our message to the world is that there is rest in Jesus Christ.

10. Now is the day of salvation

2 Cor 6:2 For He says: "In an acceptable time I have heard you, and in the day of salvation I have helped you." Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.

John 6:44 "No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day.

John 6:65 And He said, "Therefore I have said to you that no one can come to Me unless it has been granted to him by My Father."

John 12:32 "And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all peoples to Myself."

Receive Jesus while you are able to do so. The person who does not have Jesus as his Savior is not promised tomorrow. While you feel the drawing of the Holy Spirit, while you are able to think of turning to God, turn to Him. It is God's mercy that people are repeatedly called. Turn to Jesus now, while you are able to do to.

11. Peace with God

Rom 5:1-2

1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

2 through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

John 3:36 "He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."

The opposite of having the wrath of God on you is to have peace with God. We have peace with God and have the peace of God as we trust Jesus to be our Savior. Through Jesus we have access into the grace which enables us to stand.

Phil 4:6-7

6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;

7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

12. Righteous scarcely saved

1 Pet 4:18 Now "If the righteous one is scarcely saved, where will the ungodly and the sinner appear?"

Psalm 1:5-6

5 Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

6 For the LORD knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

1 Cor 1:30 But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God-- and righteousness and sanctification and redemption--

The only way we can be righteous, that is, have right standing with God, is through receiving Jesus Christ as Lord. Man can never through his own works become good enough in the sight of God. Call on Jesus Christ to save you.

13. For God so loved the world

John 3:16 "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Rom 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Isa 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

Even though each of us has sinned and gone astray, God made a way for us to be saved. God cannot overlook sin, but God has made a way for sin to be forgiven. The way is Jesus Christ. God so loved the world so much, 'that he gave his only begotten Son' that whosoever believes on Jesus will not perish, but have eternal life.

14. Prodigal son welcomed home

Luke 15:20-24

20 "And he arose and came to his father. But when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion, and ran and fell on his neck and kissed him.

21 "And the son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight, and am no longer worthy to be called your son.'

22 "But the father said to his servants, 'Bring out the best robe and put it on him, and put a ring on his hand and sandals on his feet.

23 'And bring the fatted calf here and kill it, and let us eat and be merry;

24 'for this my son was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' And they began to be merry.

This parable shows the great love God has for the lost. If a person is away from God, they have only to turn towards God. The Bible says, 'Whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.' The name of the Lord is Jesus. Call on Jesus and you will be saved. No matter how far you may have strayed, God is waiting to welcome you back with arms of love. God will put the best robe on you, that is, the robe of righteousness. God will provide for you as you dwell in his house.

15. Count the cost

Luke 14:26-29

26 "If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple.

27 "And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple.

28 "For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not sit down first and count the cost, whether he has enough to finish it--

29 "lest, after he has laid the foundation, and is not able to finish, all who see it begin to mock him,

Jesus told the multitudes who went with him to count the cost of coming after Him. We are to love God so much that in comparison it seems that we hate our family. God will help us and empower us to live for Him. At the same time we have to make the decision that we are going all the way with Jesus.

16. Lost coin found

Luke 15:8-10

8 "Or what woman, having ten silver coins, if she loses one coin, does not light a lamp, sweep the house, and search carefully until she finds it?

9 "And when she has found it, she calls her friends and neighbors together, saying, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found the piece which I lost!'

10 "Likewise, I say to you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."

1 Pet 1:19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

Psalm 49:8 (For the redemption of their soul is precious, and it ceaseth for ever:)

This parable shows how precious each lost person is to God. God paid the price of his only Son. Each lost person is so precious to God that He will search for them and find them. Each person has to use their own will to receive the free gift of salvation that God offers.

17. Foolishness of preaching

Rom 10:13-15

13 For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

14 How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher?

15 And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, who bring glad tidings of good things!"

Tit 1:3 but has in due time manifested His word through preaching, which was committed to me according to the commandment of God our Savior;

Isa 10:27 It shall come to pass in that day that his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, and his yoke from your neck, and the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil.

The gospel of Jesus Christ is the gospel of peace. Jesus Christ is the Prince of Peace. The glad tidings are that people can be free from sin, have a good life and have eternal life through Jesus Christ. The gospel is given to us to preach to others. We are preaching the gospel as we proclaim the Word of God with the empowerment of the Holy Spirit. We are not called to argue or dispute with people the gospel; we are to preach the gospel. The Holy Spirit quickens the message to the preacher. The Holy Spirit breaks the yoke of sin in a person's life so that they can hear and receive the gospel of peace. Receive Jesus, the Prince of Peace.

18. By grace are ye saved

Eph 2:8-9

8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,

9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.

Tit 3:5 not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit,

It is God's grace and mercy that we are able to hear the gospel. This grace and mercy is like a gift extended to us. Receive salvation through Jesus Christ while you are able to do so.

19. I am the way

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

Psa 43:3 Oh, send out Your light and Your truth! Let them lead me; let them bring me to Your holy hill and to Your tabernacle.

Jesus is the Way to eternal life. He is also the Way in this life. As we abide in Jesus, He, who is light and truth will lead us. Jesus is the only way to God the Father. To reject Jesus is to turn to the true Light of the world. Let Jesus be the Way, the Truth and the life for you.

Joh 1:9 That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world.

20. I am the vine

Joh 15:5 "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

When we receive Jesus as the Lord of our life, we become to Jesus even as a branch is attached to a tree. As we abide in Jesus, the very nature of God will flow into you producing good fruit in your life. You will not have to struggle to produce the good results. The good fruit will come naturally as you abide in Jesus. We abide in Jesus by abiding in His Word and by fellowshiping with Him in prayer. The good fruit is the love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness and self-control

being manifested in our lives. The good fruit is to help others come to know Jesus Christ.

21. Confess the Lord Jesus

Rom 10:9-10

9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

The way to be saved is simple. The Bible says, 'whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.' Call on Jesus to save you. Say with your mouth, 'Jesus, you are the Lord of my life.' Believe with everything in you that God raised Jesus from the dead. To believe this is to believe that Jesus was and is in fact the Son of God and God proved it by raising Jesus from the dead. As you confess Jesus as the Lord of your life and believe that God raised Him from the dead you are saved from damnation and saved to eternal life with God.

22. Others save with fear

Jude 1:21-23

21 keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

22 And on some have compassion, making a distinction;

23 but others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire, hating even the garment defiled by the flesh.

While our main emphasis is the love of God, there is a time to warn people of a real hell. It is so real that Jesus told of a man who was there in torment and asked for just a drop of water on his tongue. After one dies it is too late to turn to God. Part of the anguish in hell will be the remembrance of the many ignored chances to turn to God. Another part of the anguish there will be knowing that other people might not be in hell if life had been lived for God. Turn to Jesus now while you can and bring others to Jesus.

23. I am the door

John 10:7-9

7 Then Jesus said to them again, "Most assuredly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep.

8 "All who ever came before Me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not hear them.

9 "I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.

Rev 3:7

7 "And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write, 'These things says He who is holy, He who is true, "He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens":

Right now Jesus is the door to eternal life. Right now the door is open for whosoever to enter. As we enter the door, Jesus Christ, we are saved. In Jesus we will find the pasture, that is, we will find God supplying our needs. Let us show others the door, Jesus Christ, so that they too might be saved and find pasture. As we enter the fold through Jesus, we will be saved to eternal life and be able to turn away from those who would want to harm us.

24. Save yourselves from corruption

Acts 2:40 And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation."

Matt 7:13-14

13 "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it.

14 "Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.

Each of us must receive Jesus Christ as Savior to be born again and to be right with God. Peter in the book of Acts admonished the people there to save themselves from their corrupt generation. It is no excuse to think everyone else is doing wrong. Whether there be few or many who follow Jesus Christ where you are, keep your eyes on Jesus and take the narrow way which leads to eternal life.

25. Lost sheep found

Luke 15:4-7

4 "What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he loses one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness, and go after the one which is lost until he finds it?

5 "And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing.

6 "And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!'

7 "I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance.

This parable that Jesus told shows how much God loves and cares for us. God wants those that are lost to be saved. That is why Christians are told to go out and tell people everywhere about Jesus. Even though there are many people saved, God wants that lost one to be saved too. If a person goes astray in life, Jesus wants them back in the fold. Jesus is the great Shepherd of the sheep who paid for the lost with His own blood. Lost people are to be sought out and then brought to the house of God.

26. Know whom I have believed

2 Tim 1:12 For this reason I also suffer these things; nevertheless I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that Day.

Jude 24 Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to present you faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy,

John 10:28-29

28 "And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.

29 "My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand.

Commit the keeping of your salvation into the hands of Jesus. He will keep you. Trust Jesus to keep you from falling. Trust Jesus to present you faultless before Him one day. Trust Jesus to keep you safe in the hand of the Father.

27. What is a man profited

Matt 16:24-26

24 Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.

25 "For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it.

26 "For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?

There is nothing in this world worth compromising for. There is nothing in this world worth being corrupt or dishonest for. Compared to having eternal life with Jesus in heaven and having His help in this life, the world has nothing to offer. Let us not be taken in by the 'deceitfulness of riches.' Make your decision today to have Jesus be the Lord of your life.

2 Pet 2:9-10

9 then the Lord knows how to deliver the godly out of temptations and to reserve the unjust under punishment for the day of judgment,

10 and especially those who walk according to the flesh in the lust of uncleanness and despise authority. They are presumptuous, self-willed. They are not afraid to speak evil of dignitaries,

28. sons of God

John 1:12-13

12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:

13 who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

Gal 3:26 For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.

Gal 4:6 And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!"

It is wonderful to know that when we are born again we are children of God. We have the Holy Spirit inside of us letting us know that we are indeed children of God. We have the nature of God inside of us that wants to live right before God. If we sin, we confess it before God and He will forgive us; we still remain children of God.

29. Does Jesus know you?

Matt 7:21-23

21 "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.

22 "Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?'

23 "And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!'

Joh 17:3 "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

It is not enough to know about Jesus Christ as a historical fact. We have eternal life as we believe on the only begotten Son of God, Jesus Christ. To believe on Jesus Christ, we must believe that Jesus is in fact the only begotten Son of God. As we do this, we are born again children of God who are known by Jesus Christ and God the Father. Without being born again, no matter how many good works a person does, they are still lost and without a relationship to God.

Isa 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

30. Ready to save

Isa 38:20 "The LORD was ready to save me; therefore we will sing my songs with stringed instruments all the days of our life, in the house of the LORD."

Neh 9:17 They refused to obey, and they were not mindful of Your wonders that You did among them. But they hardened their necks, and in their rebellion they appointed a leader to return to their bondage. But You are God, ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, abundant in kindness, and did not forsake them.

Isa 1:18 "Come now, and let us reason together," says the LORD, "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall be as wool."

Jesus is ready to save you. Whatever the situation you may be in, Jesus is ready to save you. If you are addicted to a habit that is destroying you, Jesus is ready to save your life and to save you from that habit. Jesus will completely remove the stain of sin and make you to be as white as snow.

31. Purchased with his blood

Acts 20:28 "Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood."

Heb 9:12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

Rom 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Each person is so precious in the sight of God that with the blood of His only Son he paid for our salvation. This salvation is eternal.

The Message

This book presents the same message based on different Bible passages. Jesus Christ is the only one who can save you by the Holy Spirit. If you have never asked the Lord Jesus Christ into your life as Savior, do so right now. Pray the following prayer:
